

Pink Hill Town Board Meeting Minutes January 13, 2026

This month's Board of Commissioner's meeting was held on January 13, 2026 at 7:00 pm in Robert Elmore Board Room. Present at the meeting were: Mayor Mike Horne, Commissioners Brandon Marshburn, Michael Whitfeld & Joshua Eing, Town Clerk Lauren Smith, Town Attorney Anna Herring & Police Officers Hoffman & Weaver.

Visitors present were: Tony Esposito, Trina Patrick & Jennifer Murphy.

Mayor Horne called the meeting to order & led the Pledge of Allegiance. He then referenced meeting protocol & the conflict-of-interest statement.

Public Comments:

Tony Esposito began with a recap of the 2025 Pink Hill Neighborhood Watch Program & his vision for the program's future.

Next, Dr. Jennifer Murphy announced & requested a road closure for the 2026 Pink Hill Easter Eggstravaganza to be held on March 28th from 1-4 pm at the Jones Avenue Park, & the Easter Bunny After Dark Adult Egg Hunt to be held the evening before on March 27th from 7-10pm at Tower110.

Approval of the Agenda:

- Commissioner Marshburn made a motion to approve the January agenda with an amendment to add the approval of Lisa Jones to replace Josh Eing as a Planning Board member.

- Vote was unanimous; motion carries

Approval of the Minutes:

Financial Reports:

The Clerk noted that Financial Reports were up to date with the exception of the Water Fund, with the prior month's report being included in binders.

Department Reports:

- Mayor Horne gave water department updates. The Park Circle project will be the first Water & Sewer Capital Improvement Project to commence. The Utility department will temporarily reopen Carol Drive as there is not a consensus yet on how to address the drainage issues. "No through truck traffic" signs will be installed on Lynwood & Broadway as these streets have recently been paved.
- The Fire Report was included in binders, and Commissioner Marshburn will be attending their regular meetings going forward.
- The Monthly Police Report was read by Commissioner Whitfield

Agenda Items:

First, Mayor Horne asked for a motion to approve Dr. Murphy's road closure request to close Jones Avenue from Macon to Walnut from 9am to 5pm on Saturday, March 28th.

Mayor Horne next requested a motion to approve the Engineering Service agreement submitted by Harvin Engineering, PLLC for the upcoming Lead Service Line Inventory project.

Finally, Mayor Horne requested a motion to approve his recommendation for Mona Lisa Jones to fill the vacant Planning Board position for the remainder of newly elected Commissioner Joshua Eing's current term.

- Vote was unanimous; motion carries

Commissioner Marshburn noted the success of the Mobile Dentistry Event held by Community Connections on January 10th.


