

# **Pink Hill Town Board Meeting Minutes February 10, 2026**

This month's Board of Commissioner's meeting was held on February 10, 2026 at 7:00 pm in Robert Elmore Board Room. Present at the meeting were: Mayor Mike Horne, Commissioners Brandon Marshburn, Michael Whitfeld & Joshua Eing, Town Clerk Lauren Smith, Town Attorney Anna Herring & Police Officers Hoffman & Weaver.

Mayor Horne called the meeting to order & led the Pledge of Allegiance. He then referenced meeting protocol & the conflict-of-interest statement.

- Commissioner Marshburn noted that there was no Fire Report as of the meeting, but he had spoken with Chief Smith & the Department will be updating their S.O.G.s to be approved at the next Town Board meeting.

- The Monthly Police Report was read by Commissioner Whitfield.

**Agenda Items:**

First, Slade Harvin with Harvin Engineering, PLLC gave an introduction & overview of the upcoming Lead Service Line Inventory project that the Town was recently notified of funding approval to complete & fielded questions presented by the Board.

Next, B.J. Murphy proposed the Board approve a request to the General Assembly to move the Town to even-year elections & restore early voting that had been previously requested to be removed from the Town Charter.

- Commissioner Whitfield then made a motion to request an amendment to the Town Charter to Restore early voting
- Seconded by Commissioner Marshburn
